Hydro One will work in your community

In order to provide a continued supply of safe and reliable electricity to the City of Hamilton, Hydro One regularly patrols all transmission corridors to maintain safe clearance between vegetation and lines.

As part of this work, our Forestry Technician has identified that a few trees in the high voltage transmission corridor will need to be trimmed. All trees that require trimming will be have a blue mark.

What work is happening?

In order to maintain safe clearances from our high-voltage transmission lines and other electrical infrastructure, Hydro One Forestry crews will need to trim a few trees adjacent the hydro corridor.

Why is this work important?

Safety is our top priority. It's our responsibility to ensure that trees and other vegetation remain in a safe proximity to the high-voltage transmission lines and electrical infrastructure in your community, and across the province.

How will the work be completed?

Work will be completed using manual equipment, such as chainsaws and pruners.
