The next Beach Community Council Meeting is Tuesday, March 10th at 7:30 pm at the Hamilton Beach Rescue Unit.

Our last meeting was on Tuesday, January 14, 2020. Items that were discussed:

- Discussion of the roads being redone on the boulevard, including a bike lane on the Bay side and the removal of the centre line. Discussion of whether or not we can get more bus stops and bus shelters after the completion of the road resurfacing
- Community member Robert has been doing an inventory down on the beach of homes that are vacant / abandoned, missing street signs and damaged historical signs he will report back when he has completed this. Thank you for undertaking this project!
- Discussed the electronic billboard signs that are being placed on Eastport Drive we will
  discuss the revenue aspect of this at our next meeting and make a decision so we can let the
  Port Authority know
- Ed, Chairperson of the Beach Council attends the CLC meetings for Arecelor-Matel with Pam. Unfortunately, Pam has had to step down and Ed is now looking for someone who can attend these meetings with him.
- If you experience particulate matter on your property, please report it to the Ministry of the Environment so it can be recorded and addressed
- We are currently working on putting our constitution together. Thank you to Carol for working on this. The council will look at the proposed constitution and put it forth to the membership once it has been completed
- Water levels will continue to be high again this year. The city is looking at putting in Armor stone on the beach to try and protect what is left of the beach as it is continuing to erode with the high-water levels
- Terri would like to put together a list of things that need fixing / updating / improved on the Beach and give it to Chad Collins to have done.

For the last couple of years, the Port has allowed the storage of mountains of road salt that when left uncovered or moved impacts the residents in the area. Unlike coal dust, salt can corrode and damage your home and vehicle. The salt companies have moved these piles further north on Eastport Drive this year and the impacted areas border on the side streets between Locarno Avenue and Knapman Avenue.
