It is that time of the year again when runners take over Hamilton in the Around the Bay Road Race. On Sunday, March 29th, 2020, come on out and cheer on the runners. The race begins at 9:30am and has a 4.5 hour time limit for completion. The race route is as follows:

The race begins on York Blvd and Caroline St. N, proceeds east on York Blvd, left north onto James St. N, then east onto Burlington St, proceeding east on Burlington using the overpasses to the Woodward Ave, exiting north onto Woodward Ave. onto the Beach Strip. After crossing the Canal lift bridge the race turns onto Eastport Drive to Northshore Blvd then west bound onto the rolling hills of Northshore Blvd., and then west onto Plains Rd entering Hamilton on York Blvd. and finishing at First Ontario Centre.

Our Neighbourhood – A Walk with Robert Fraser

Hamilton Beach resident, Robert Fraser has been walking the neighbourhood, taking an inventory on different things. In this edition of the Banner, we are reporting on “Where have all the streets signs gone”, postal boxes and fire hydrants.

Street signs:

- Manor Ave, there is a Trail (T) sign but no Beach Blvd (BB) end sign. I’m told the missing sign is in good hands
- Until just recently (Feb 19) no sign on Pandora (T) end but now on BB end
- 4th Ave has no (BB) sign or (T) sign, but there is a sign at the bus stop on the bayside
- Killarney has no (T) sign
- Woodland has no (T) sign

Fire Hydrants:

On a brighter note we seem to be well served with fire hydrants. Blue bonnets (or tops) have the greatest volume 95+ litres/sec while red are the weakest at 31 litres/sec. In driving along the lakeside there are 39 hydrants, one at 1117 appears to red, and one at 935 appears also to be red. Most every bayside street has one hydrant except Bayside (I could not find one). Wark has one at the corner with Beach Blvd. In the 2-town house complexes each one has 2 red hydrants. Interesting to note that some lakeside streets also have hydrants – Fitch for one.

Postal Boxes:

Good news is that we have 3 Canada Post collection boxes on the bayside.

For the last couple of years, the Port has allowed the storage of mountains of road salt that when left uncovered or moved impacts the residents in the area. Unlike coal dust, salt can corrode and damage your home and vehicle. The salt companies have moved these piles further north on Eastport Drive this year and the impacted areas border on the side streets between Locarno Avenue and Knapman Avenue. We ask that residents keep watch during times of high winds and report all occurrences to the MOE and please contact the community so that we can keep track as well – hbcf@cogeco.ca
