- Presentation from Lee, Serena and Andrew regarding the property close to the Rescue Unit that is for sale (3 lots). Wanted input on what the community would want in a build in that location. They will put together a full presentation and have been invited back to speak to council at a later date
- Discussion of the electronic signs that the Port is planning on putting up on Eastport Drive
- Carol has been working on the Beach Community Council Constitution
- Discussion of 600 Beach Blvd and the Committee of Adjustment was brought up and that members of the community and council would be going to the CoA meeting
- Discussion of maintenance to the lot next to 642 Beach Blvd and who is responsible for lawn maintenance and trash / litter pick-up – advised to reach out directly to Chad Collins
- Concerns raised that there are not enough bus shelters on Beach Blvd – this will be brought to Chad Collin's attention

Particulate and Salt Fallout

For the last couple of years, the Port has allowed the storage of mountains of road salt that when left uncovered or moved impacts the residents in the area. Unlike coal dust, salt can corrode and damage your home and vehicle. The salt companies have moved these piles further north on Eastport Drive this year and the impacted areas border on the side streets between Locarno Avenue and Knapman Avenue.
